What should I already know?	Vocabulary	
Be able to name different parts of the body.	Senses	Humans have 5 senses that they use to help them find out about the world around them (sight, hearing, taste, smell & touch)
	Hearing	You use your ears to hear e.g. music, the sea, animals
Know the uses of some parts of the body.	Sight	You use your eyes to see e.g. colours, friends, pets, flowers
	Smell	You use your nose to smell e.g. food, perfume, places
	Taste	You use your tongue to taste e.g. sweet, sour and spicy food
Be able to describe some things associated with the seasons	Touch	You use your hands to touch e.g. climbing equipment, toys, cushions, pets, pencils
	Human body	The human body is made up of many different parts. Each part of the body has a specific job to do. Each part works together so we can eat, live, breathe, eat, dance and so much more!
	Bones	Your bones make up the skeleton in our bodies. The smallest bone is in your ear!
	Season	A time of the year. There are 4 seasons in this country
	Autumn	The season that follows Summer
	Winter	The season that follows Autumn
