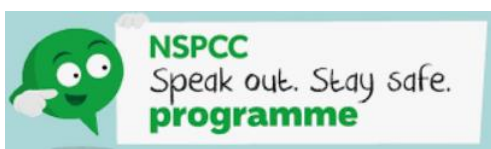
**Spring Term Citizenship**
